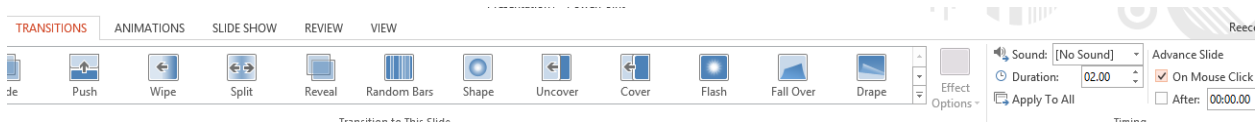


How to Write on PowerPoint Slides While in Presentation Mode

You can do this on a new PowerPoint or on an existing PowerPoint!

It has been brought to my attention that when trying to write on a PowerPoint presentation, it is difficult to write and not accidentally advance the slide. Here is the solution.

On the Menu Bar Choose Transitions and on the far right hand side you will see a check mark in "On Mouse Click". Take this off. Make sure all slides are selected. This way, when you click on the board while writing the slide will not advance.



Now that this is off, you can advance your slides or even write on them with your finger. Look at the screen shot below. It will show up when you DO NOT have a pen in your hand.



Use your finger to advance to the next slide or click the pen with your finger and write on the board. If you choose to use your pen to write, you must lay it down in the tray before the above image appears so you have the choice to advance the slide.
