What is Bullying?

Bullying refers to any intentional act by a student or groups of students directed against another student to ridicule, humiliate, or intimidate the other student while on school grounds, or at a school sponsored activity, which acts are repeated against the same student over time. (MCSD Students 09.422)

Examples of Bullying Actions physical builying verbal bullying emotional/social bullying hitting, punching teasing/name calling leaving people out pinching, tripping making offensive remarks Spreading rumors kicking, pushing ☐ making discriminatory B excluding someone scratching, spitting remarks ignoring someone damaging/stealing property insulting someone making fun of someone throwing objects at someone threatening someone stopping people from hiding/taking belongings ☐ repeated teasing befriending someone other intimidating someone Other □ other

3 rd OFFENSE	Teacher contacts parents and isolation in classicom.	Parent Signature
4 th OFFENSE Date	Loss of all privileges (lunch detention, no snack, no recess, walk during games at PE). Principal calls parents	Parent Signature
5th OFFENSE Date	Parent conference with teacher, principal, student and Randy Murphy (Dropout Prevention Coordinator), Kevin Cloyd (Safe Schools Coordinator). Parents will receive informational packet with bullying information.	Parent Signature
6 th OFFENSE Date	1 Week In-school Suspension K-4 or 1 Week Falcon Academy 5 th grade	Parent Signature
7 th OFFENSE Date	Meeting with principal, student, parent, Kevin Cloyd, Permanent assignment to Falcon Academy	Paroni Signature
