



Tompkinsville-Monroe County Chamber of Commerce Scholarship

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide financial assistance to a 2023 graduate of Monroe County High School who desires to further their education at an institute of higher learning (college, university or vocational school).

Criteria

1. GPA of 2.5 or better on a 4.0 scale
2. Must exhibit strong leadership in school and community organizations.
3. Must enroll in an institution of higher learning in the fall of 2023.
4. Must complete application.
5. Must graduate from high school in the year the application is submitted.
6. The student, their parent(s) or their employer must be a member of the Tompkinsville-Monroe County Chamber of Commerce for at least one year.
7. Proof of enrollment must be presented to the Tompkinsville-Monroe County Chamber of Commerce before the \$500 check will be issued.

Application must be turned in to the high school guidance counselor no later than April 28, 2023.

1. Submit an official transcript with application.
(5 points)

2. List, in chronological order, all schools or training courses you have attended during high school.
(5 points)

3. List any honors received while attending high school.
(5 points)

4. List any leadership roles you have held while attending high school. Include offices, roles and memberships to school or community organizations.
(10 points)

Study Proposal

1. Submit an essay (at least 500 words) that explains how your secondary education will change your community.
(20 points)

2. Name and address of the college, university or vocational school you plan to attend.
(5 points)

3. List and describe the course of study you plan to take.
(5 points)

Work Experience

1. List all work experience. Include name, dates, positions held & supervisor name.
(5 points)

Volunteer and Community Service Experience

1. List volunteer work and/or community service activities you have been involved in, along with the name of a contact person for verification.
(15 points)

2. List clubs, activities you participated in during high school.
(10 points)

References

1. Submit three letters of recommendation. One must be from a teacher and two from community leaders (can not be from family).
(15 points)
