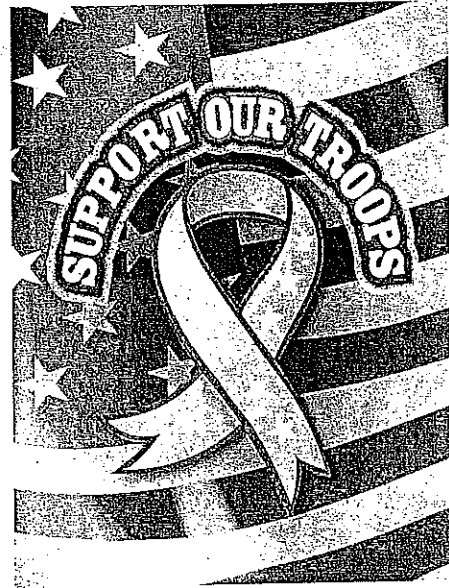


# Military Care Packages
